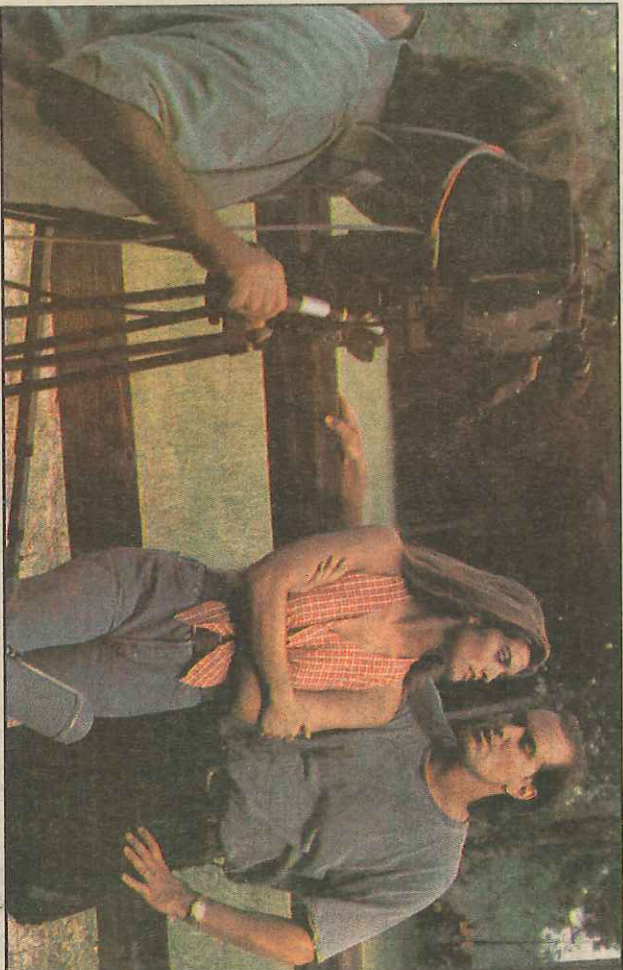
"I just had to eat," Zadrick said Monday, finishing her sandwich.
